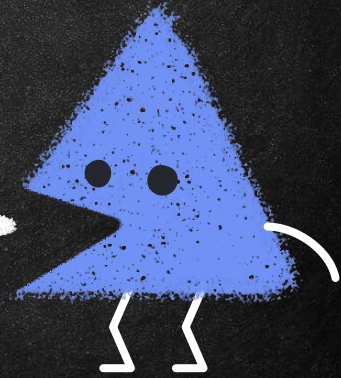
# WHAT IS GPA?

- ❖ Grade Point Average (GPA) is a numerical summary of the grades received for high school credit.
- ❖ GPA is used to determine class rank.
- ❖ Colleges use rank and GPA to make admissions decisions.



# HOW IS GPA DETERMINED?

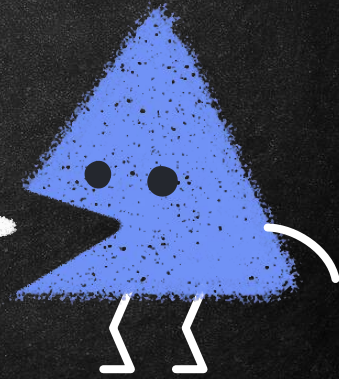
- ❖ “Points” are assigned to the average a student earns in each class for each semester

# PFISD WEIGHTED GPA SCALE

- ❖ Tier 1 represents Advanced-Level Courses where students could earn up to 6 GPA Points.
- ❖ Tier 2 General Education Courses - Includes Pre-AP courses and other approved courses where students could earn up to 5 GPA Points. (Dual Credit begins with 2023 graduating class)
- ❖ Tier 3 General Education Courses - Include grade level TEKS courses where students could earn up to 4 GPA Points.
- ❖ Tier 4 General Education Courses - Any course that has been modified as to the required content of the TEKS where students could earn up to 3 GPA Points.
- ❖ The District shall convert semester grades earned in eligible courses to grade points in accordance with the following table and shall calculate a weighted GPA:
