2022 AP Support Sessions

Students enrolled in an AP course are automatically registered to take an AP exam for 2021-2022 when they join their MY AP class. For an exam to be ordered for a student in each AP class they are registered in, an initial down payment of \$40 (\$15 free/reduced lunch) per exam taken must be received by November 5, 2021. Students may pay the entire exam fee of \$86 or, if paying in installments, the remaining \$46 balance for each exam ordered will be due by March 4, 2024. Second semester only courses will pay for exams in full by March 4, 2024, or students may pay in full in November if desired. **Note:** exams will not be ordered unless a down payment for each exam ordered has been paid by November 5, 2021. Full payment must be received by March 4 or exams will be cancelled.

- Pay for the exam in Total Registration

 2. Select Exam and Payment Amount (\$15 F/R; \$40 down payment; \$86 full price exam) *Note: students making down payment for exam will need to pay additional \$46 exam fee or amount required to complete full payment for exam by March 4, 2022 deadline.*

Exam fees:

\$86 per test

\$15 per test – students qualifying for free and reduced lunch

Late order or [Late Testing Fee with additional fee](#) –

\$86 + \$40 = \$126 ALL students

\$15 + \$40 + \$55 F/R Lunch students

Financial Need Scholarships:

Students not qualifying for free and reduced lunch who elect to take more than one AP examination and have a clear financial need may apply for a limited number of AP exam scholarships. For each test taken beyond the first test, applicants may be awarded \$30 to assist with exam fees.

Scholarship applications must be submitted by October 29, 2021. A campus committee will determine scholarship award.

- All students testing who earn a qualifying score (3 or higher) **will be eligible for exam fee reimbursement by PFISD.** The parent or guardian paying for the exam will be sent a check from PFISD for the actual amount paid for each qualifying exam in August/September 2022. *Processing fees, scholarship fees, and late fees are not reimbursable.*

2022 AP Exam Calendar and Schedule:

AP testing begins Monday, May 2 and concludes Friday, May 13, 2022. [Late testing dates will occur between Tuesday, May 17 and Friday, May 20, 2022.](#)

Late testing is available for students with pre-approval from campus AP test coordinators. Approval for alternate testing must be made prior to exam day with the exception outlined by College Board. Note that late arrival is not a reason for alternate testing. Our expectation is for students to behave as responsible scholars and be on time.

AP EXAM SCHEDULE

- Morning exams require that the students arrive no later than 7:30 a.m.
- Afternoon exams require that the students arrive no later than 11:30 a.m.
- Mid-Afternoon exams require that students arrive no later than 2:00 p.m.

Please be aware that if you are not on time to your AP exam, you will not be able to sit for the exam and will forfeit your exam fee. For example, if your exam begins at 8:00 a.m., and you arrive at 8:01 a.m., you will not be allowed into the testing room. This is also the policy for the AP pre-admin sessions.

Please leave cell phones and all other devices in a secured location that is not inside the testing room. Any distractions caused by an unauthorized device will result in canceling your test scores. Make sure that if your test allows a calculator, you use only an approved calculator for your exam. Otherwise, your exam score will be canceled.
